


General Information

Meeting Information:

Speakers Bureau:

All CSAA members have the opportunity to voluntarily participate in the Speakers Bureau. This bureau serves the purpose of educating the community about the benefits of living a sober life in addition to the consequences given for not doing so. This bureau also provides its members who participate with an opportunity to share their experiences and triumphs with others who may be at risk.



Mentor Program:

The CSAA's mentor program is a voluntary program in which Alumni members have the chance to help current Drug/DUI Court participants deal with any problems they may be experiencing. CSAA members who are interested are matched with a current Drug/DUI Court participant and are available to meet face-to-face to give advice and assistance.

Relapse Panel:

The CSAA relapse panel consists of members who agree to be available to give guidance to other members or current Drug/DUI Court participants in the event that someone is thinking about or has relapsed.
