



DATA Pricing Structure

EFFECTIVE January 1, 2015

The follow are the different pricing tiers that DeKalb County is offering for connectivity through the DATA fiber network:

Full Membership

Full membership is for transport connectivity over the DATA network or connectivity between buildings that have more than five connections within the facility being connected.

\$7,000/Year connectivity into the DATA Network
\$500 one time administrative fee

New Customer responsibilities:

- Customer is responsible for cost to install backbone extensions, laterals and drops to location(s) not served by the grant-funded build-out.
- Customer is responsible for fiber end equipment for added locations and for any upgrades required to the backbone equipment to add the additional locations.

Membership Includes:

- Membership to the DATA committee that is a steering committee for DeKalb County on making technical decisions for the DATA network.
- A 1 Gigabit connection into the DATA network that includes:
 - o Connectivity into the DATA cloud that allows unrestricted communications between other like institutions (e.g. School Network, Municipal network)
 - o For qualified institutions, connectivity to the Illinois Century Network (ICN)
 - o Members not qualified for ICN will be connected to an ISP on the network. (Currently NIU can quote ISP Services)
 - o 24/7 Network Operations Center support of the DATA network with dispatch services if required.
- Entitlement to sparing resources of equipment provided in the event of an equipment failure dependent on availability)
- Ability to request and have available dark fiber resources at the same rate to other facilities.
- Connectivity options to Northern Illinois University and Kishwaukee Community College.
- Includes initial switch provided with grant funds.

Full Membership Subsidized Costs

This connectivity is for fiber between facilities that are low services specialized equipment of five or less connections.

\$1,250/Year connectivity, one full membership required, up to five locations.



- Full membership required at primary location.
- Up to two fiber strands will be provided along any given path, no additional overlay of fiber will be provided.
- Customer is responsible for cost to install backbone extensions, laterals and drops to location(s) not served by the grant-funded build-out.
- Customer is responsible for fiber end equipment for added locations and for any upgrades required to the backbone equipment to add the additional locations.
- DATA only provides support on assuring the fiber is maintained and passes quality controls.
- 24/7 support for fiber service, dispatch if fiber broken.

Subscriber Services

This connectivity is for facilities that have five or fewer computers, low traffic impact, open on a part time basis or levy's less than \$175,000/year

\$2,800/Year 100Mb Subscriber Service

\$1,050/Year 50Mb Subscriber Service

- This connectivity is for single facilities that have five or fewer computers.
- Customer is responsible for cost of fiber to facility, fiber end equipment and any upgrades required to the backbone equipment to add the additional location.
- Connection is for transport to an internet service provider.
- Support is limited to normal business hours and next business day.
 - Support is to the end point provided by DATA to assure quality of connection.
 - First tier support and after hours will be with the internet service provider.
- Cost of ISP is separate from the cost of this connection.
