

Frequently Asked Questions – 2016 2nd CRT TV collection event

Q: How many TVs can I recycle?

A: You can recycle up to two TVs at no cost. You will have to pay DC Trash for additional TVs.

Q: How much does it cost to recycle more than two TVs?

A: TVs under 19 inches are \$20 to recycle. TVs over 19 inches are \$30 to recycle. Residents will receive a discount coupon of equal value. Only cash will be accepted during these events.

Q: What is the value of the Coupon DC Trash offers?

A: If you spend \$20 to recycle your small TV, under 19", then you receive a coupon for \$20 off the cost of a roll off dumpster rental. If you recycle a TV, over 19 inches then you will receive a coupon valued at \$30 off the cost of a roll off dumpster rental.

Q: What is a CRT TV?

A: CRT stands for Cathode Ray Tube Televisions. This is an older larger TV that is not a flat screen. We are also accepting projection TVs and console TVs (TVS with wood frames around them that sit on the floor).

Q: Will someone help me unload my car?

A: DC Trash Staff will help unload your car.

Q: Can I bring in my neighbor/friend/relative's TVs?

A: If that person has a reservation yes you can bring it in at your scheduled reservation time.

Q: Can I make a reservation for another person while I am on the line?

A: No each person must make his or her own reservation

Q: Is there a limit on the size of the TV I can bring?

A: No you can bring any size TV as long as it is a CRT, projection, Tube or a console TV, no flat screen TVs will be accepted. They are still accepted at the monthly electronics collection events.

Q: Can I bring other electronics besides CRTs/Tube/Projection/Console TVs?

A: No, the monthly electronics collections take these items.

Q: When are the electronics collections?

A: DeKalb – 1st Sat. 9am - 11am Grove and S. 4th St. municipal parking lot

Sandwich – 2nd Sat. 12:30pm - 2:30 pm 750 Duvick at the East Water tower

Sycamore – 3rd Sat. 9am - 11 am 475 N. Cross St. Public Works

Waterman – 4th Sat. (Feb, Apr, Jun, Aug, Oct, Dec) 9am – 11 am City Lot Route 30

Shabbona – 4th Sat. (Jan, Mar, May, Jul, Sep, Nov) 9am – 11am 206 S. Blackhawk Rd.

Q: What happens if I miss my reservation time or have a TV to recycle after this event?

A: You may not drop off TVs outside of your reservation time for free recycling. TVs taken to DC Trash before or after this collection event will be subject to DC Trash's pricing. Residents may also wait until next year, we will have another collection in 2017.
