Supplemental Information: Agricultural Lands Aerial Applications

FPL Energy Illinois Wind, LLC (FPLE Illinois Wind) will institute a hotline for aerial applicators to call to notify FPL of their application schedule. This will be to both for the safety of FPL maintenance personnel and so that turbines in the area to be sprayed can be shut down during the aerial application, if necessary.

In addition, FPLE Illinois Wind offers two possible potential remedies for concerns about aerial spraying costs.

Proposal One: FPLE Illinois Wind would reimburse non-participating landowners for the additional cost of aerial application due to the presence of wind turbines for all land within one-half mile of any turbine. FPLE Illinois Wind would pay the difference between the cost of acreage sprayed outside the one-half mile distance and acreage within the one-half mile distance. Where a landowner intends to make a claim to FPLE Illinois Wind for such reimbursement, that landowner shall contact FPLE Illinois Wind prior to executing a contract for aerial spraying which contains terms more costly than for land not containing turbines, in order to allow FPLE Illinois Wind the right to seek alternate competitive bids for the work.

Alternative Proposal Two: FPLE Illinois Wind would sponsor a program of annual spraying requiring non-participating landowners to opt in to the program by November 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. By opting in, non-participating landowners would elect to have their property included in one general competitive bid for all land included in the spraying program.
