DeKalb County Government is receiving bids for utility relocations to the Sheriff's Radio Tower. Bid documents are available by filling out a Bidder's Information Form which is available on the County's website, [www.dekalbcounty.org/invitationtobid/html](http://www.dekalbcounty.org/invitationtobid/html). A pre-bid Meeting and walk-thru will be held on Tuesday, March 22, 2016 at 10:00am local time in the DeKalb County Legislative Center Gathertorium, 200 N. Main Street, Sycamore, IL 60178. Sealed bids are due Thursday, March 31, at 10:00am local time, at DeKalb County Legislative Center Administration Office at 200 North Main Street, Second Floor, Sycamore, IL 60178.

The work includes duct installation, electrical power, copper communications cables and fiber optic cables installation and removal of retired services.

This contract requires compliance with the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/.01 *et seq.* ("the Act"). The Act requires contractors and subcontractors to pay laborers, workers and mechanics performing services on public works projects no less than the "prevailing rate of wages" (hourly cash wages plus fringe benefits) in the county where the work is performed.
