

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the "Public Building Commission Act", Illinois Revised Statutes 1977, Chapter 85, Sections 1031 through 1054, empowers county boards to establish a public building commission to construct and renovate public improvements, buildings and facilities, pursuant to said Act; and


WHEREAS, the DeKalb County Board after considerable investigation and research recognizes that the DeKalb County Government has certain inadequate and outmoded public improvements, buildings and facilities for the furnishing of essential Governmental services, and for use in the conduct of the County Government by its various branches, departments and agencies, and that as a consequence thereof, the quantity and quality of services delivery is adversely affected, and the County Board is compelled to expend large sums of money annually in the rental, operation and maintenance of additional facilities to house the various branches, departments and agencies of the County Government to meet this ever-increasing need for adequate public improvements, buildings and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the DeKalb County Board has after long and serious contemplation determined that there is a need and that it is in the best interest of the public that a public building commission be organized to exercise the powers and authority prescribed by the "Public Building Commission Act" to satisfy the aforesaid need for adequate public improvements, buildings and facilities, in that the public building commission presents the most cost-effective and otherwise best means for satisfying said need;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the DeKalb County Board that it does create and establish the DeKalb County Public Building Commission, pursuant to the "Public Building Commission Act", for the purpose of constructing and renovating needed public improvements, buildings and facilities for the DeKalb County Government.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the DeKalb County Board that it does direct its Chairman to cause a copy of this resolution to be published once in a newspaper or newspapers having a circulation in the City of Sycamore, and to cause to be filed in the office of the DeKalb County Recorder of Deeds not earlier than sixty days nor later than seventy days thereafter a certified copy of this resolution and such other documents as required by law.
