Credit Recovery (Edgenuity) Protocol

Besides current truants and chronic truants, a student may be enrolled in Edgenuity Credit Recovery through the Regional Office of Education if they are identified as a Potential Dropout with Attendance Issues. The DeKalb ROE DCTIP/TAOEP Credit Recovery Enrollment Form must be filled out and submitted to Denise Curran.

Definition of Potential Dropout with Attendance Issues:

Any student subject to compulsory attendance and whose school absences or pattern of school attendance impedes the student's learning or contributes to the student's failure to meet the Illinois Learning Standards and/or district learning standards (23 IL Adm. Code 205.20(b)(4))

DeKalb County Truancy Intervention uses the following guidelines to enroll students as Potential Dropouts with Attendance Issues for credit recovery:

1. A student who is currently served by the DeKalb County Truancy Intervention Program (current truants/chronic truants) or.....
2. A student who has 5 or more of any combination of the following 3 criteria since the beginning of the school year may be referred to the DeKalb County Truancy Intervention Program for purposes of credit recovery with the approval of the Credit Recovery County Coordinator.
 - A. Excused Absence
 - B. Unexcused Absence
 - C. Tardy to School
