SNOW POLICY

- 1.1.0. The DeKalb County Sheriff, in consultation with the Presiding Judge in so far as the Courts are concerned, will determine whether or not to close those County buildings that can be closed during snow and emergencies because of his familiarity with current road and weather conditions.
- *(Revised 2/17/1988)*
- 1.1.1. As a matter of public safety, nonessential County personnel should stay home on days when the Sheriff has declared a snow emergency and closed certain County buildings.

- 1.1.2. The following compensation plan will be utilized when certain County buildings have been closed by the Sheriff:
- 1.1.2.a. All nonessential, noncontractual personnel scheduled to work should remain in their homes and off the roads. The County will deduct the hours from accumulated PHOs if any.

- 1.1.2.b. Personnel deemed essential to County operations wherever possible should report to work on such snow emergency days and will be compensated at a straight time rate for their services.
