

DEKALB COUNTY SHERIFF'S MERIT COMMISSION

MEETING MINUTES

DECEMBER 20, 2006

The DeKalb County Sheriff's Merit Commission met in the Conference Room of the County Safety Building. The meeting was called to order at 5:00 pm by Chairman Gene Lane. Commissioners Gene Lane, Bennetta Stearnes and Todd Walker were present at the meeting. Also present was Lt. Van Bomar of the County Patrol Division.

Sheriff Scott entered the meeting to request a waiver for hiring as allowed by Article III-F 4 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. The waiver if applied would be for Stephen Butterfield of the County E 911 Center in Macomb, Illinois. After a brief discussion Chairman Gene Lane called for a motion. A motion to grant a waiver for the hiring of Stephen Butterfield after he undergoes a satisfactory background, polygraph and psychological examination was made by Bennetta Stearnes and seconded by Gene Lane. The motion carried on a unanimous voice vote. Sheriff Scott left the meeting after the vote.

Six candidates for Corrections/Patrol were scheduled for interviews and all six appeared and were interviewed. This concludes the oral interviews for all the Corrections/Patrol candidates in this testing cycle. An eligibility list will be established.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:50 pm.
