

**DEKALB COUNTY SHERIFF'S MERIT COMMISSION
MEETING MINUTES**

MAY 30, 2007

The DeKalb County Merit Commission met on May 30, 2007 at 5:00 p.m. in the computer room of the City of DeKalb Municipal Annex Building.

The purpose of this meeting is to administer the Critcall examination to the 5 applicants who passed the written examination for the Telecommunications Department on May 17, 2007.

The meeting was called to order by Bennetta Stearnes, Secretary. Those present at the meeting were: Gene Lane, Chairman; Commissioners Stearnes and Walker; Lt Al Newby, Head of the Telecommunications Department; and Charles Kross, Criticall examination administrator. A temporary computer problem caused a delay in starting the examination but the problem was resolved and the examination began at approximately 5:30 p.m. Only four of the computers designated for this examination were operable. One candidate agreed to return later in the evening to take the examination as others finished. The Commissioners discussed and agreed to interview those candidates who pass the Criticall examination tonight as they complete the examination. Commissioners agreed to interview as many of the five candidates who pass as time permits.

As the successful candidates completed and passed the Criticall examination they were interviewed by all three commissioners and Lt. Al Newby in the conference room of the same building. Four of the five candidates passed the Criticall examination, and three were interviewed on this night. All three received passing scores on their interview from the three commissioners. The remaining candidate to be interviewed is scheduled for Thursday, May 31st at 5 p.m. in the conference room of the DeKalb County Safety Building.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:35 p.m.
