

DEKALB COUNTY SHERIFF'S MERIT COMMISSION

MEETING MINUTES

November 28, 2007

The Merit Commission met in the City of DeKalb Municipal Annex 205 S. 4th Street. The purpose of the meeting was to conduct the Critcall Test for candidates applying for the position of Tele-Communications Operator.

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. There were three candidates present who were scheduled to test at 5:00 p.m. Three more candidates are scheduled to test at 6:30 p.m.

Those present at the meeting were: Commissioners Bennetta Stearnes and Todd Walker. Commissioner Gene Lane was absent. Also present from the Telecommunications Department was: Lt. Al Newby and Sgt. Lisa Winkler who assisted with the Critcall Testing.

Lt. Newby gave the candidates instructions and the test began

All three candidates testing at 5:00 p.m. passed the Critcall Test.

Only two of the three candidates scheduled to test at 6:30 p.m. were present at that time. Lt. Newby gave the candidates instructions and the test began.

It should be noted that the third candidate (Zachary Kellner) arrived at 7:05 p.m. after the test had begun and was not allowed to test. All candidates were given both verbal and written notification of the time and place of the Critcall Test on the day of their oral interviews.

Both candidates testing at 6:30 passed the Critcall Test.

All candidates were told that they will be notified of their status and contacted for further testing upon selection.
