

**DEKALB COUNTY SHERIFF'S MERIT COMMISSION
MEETING MINUTES**

FEBRUARY 28, 2008

The DeKalb County Merit Commission met at 3:00 P.M. in the City of DeKalb Annex building 223 S. Fourth Street. Those present at the meeting were: Commissioners Gene Lane and Bennetta Stearnes and Lt. Al Newby of the Telecommunications Department.

The purpose of the meeting was to conduct Critical Examinations for those applicants who successfully passed the written examination for Telecommunicators on February 18th. The number of eligible applicants scheduled for the Critical examination was 13, however only 12 applicants were available on this date. One applicant (Jillian Meyer) may be allowed to take this exam during the next testing cycle. Three sessions (3:00, 5:00 and 6:30 P.M.) of the examinations were held on this day to accommodate the number of eligible applicants to the number of available computers. At the end of the testing 11 of the 12 applicants passed the Critical examination and 1 applicant failed.

As the examinations were completed and scored, the eligible applicants were given their individual oral interview times which will be held on March 3rd and March 5th.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 P.M.
