

DEKALB COUNTY SHERIFF'S MERIT COMMISSION

MEETING MINUTES

JULY 21ST AND 23RD 2008

The DeKalb County Merit Commission met on Monday, July 21st and Wednesday, July 23rd at 5 p.m. in the Conference Room of the DeKalb County Public Safety Building. The purpose of these meetings was to hold oral interviews for all the candidates who have successfully passed both the written examination and the Critical examination for a position in the Telecommunications Department during this testing cycle.

Commissioners Gene Lane, Bennetta Stearnes, and Todd Walker were present at the two day meetings. Also present at the meetings was Lt. Al Newby who heads the Telecommunications Department.

Of the sixteen applicants who were eligible for oral examinations after having passed both the written and the Critical examinations, eleven completed the oral examinations. Five either failed to appear for the examination as scheduled or called to say they were no longer interested. Of the eleven applicants who completed the oral examination, eight passed, and three failed. After interviewing all eleven applicants during the two day meeting, the meeting was adjourned on Wednesday, July 23rd at 7:40 p.m.

A final eligibility list of the eight successful candidates was compiled and submitted to the Sheriff by the secretary of the commission
