

**DeKalb County Sheriff's Merit Commission
Special Meeting for Testing**

**Monday, November 1, 2010
6:30 p.m.**

A written test was scheduled for this day for candidates who have submitted applications for positions in the Telecommunications Division of the Department. Seventy nine (79) applications were submitted by the closing date for acceptance. Fifty six of the applicants appeared this day for testing. The meeting took place in the Dekalb County Legislative Center Gathertorium.

Present at the meeting: Commissioners Gene Lane, Bennetta Stearnes and Todd Walker. Also present was Sheriff Roger Scott who welcomed the applicants and introduced the Commissioners to them. Following his opening remarks to the applicants, Sheriff Scott left the meeting.

At 6:38 p.m. Todd Walker began giving instructions for the testing and test materials were distributed to the applicants.

At 6:48 p.m. testing began.

At 7:45 p.m. all applicants had completed the tests and the testing materials were collected. Chairman Gene Lane took possession of the testing materials and will assure that they are forwarded to Profile Evaluations, Inc. for scoring. Final instructions were given to the applicants by Todd Walker for follow up by them to learn the results and make appointments for the next phase of testing. Only those applicants who receive a score of 70 or higher will progress to the next phase of testing which is Criticall.

There was a brief discussion of the availability of the Commissioners for the week of November 8th for Criticall testing and possible start of interviews. All Commissioners stated their availability to assure a quorum. Number of days to be determined by the number of applicants attaining the minimum score of 70 on tonight's written test.
