

**DeKalb County Sheriff's Merit Commission
Meeting Minutes
Monday, October 19, 2015
5:30 P.M.**

The Merit Commission met on October 19th to begin the Como recruitment process consisting of multiple meeting dates and times for the written test, computer testing and oral interviews. The Commission also discussed the Sheriff's Request for a lateral hire of Robin Ulrey to the Corrections Division.

Commissioners present at the meeting were: Vice Chairman Kim Green and Secretary, Todd Walker. Also present was Sheriff Roger Scott for the written test on 10/19/15 and Lieutenant Winckler was present for the computer tests and all interviews.

Commissioner Walker called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Sheriff Scott discussed Robin's background and experience working in Winnebago County Corrections. Sheriff asked for our approval to hire directly to the jail. Commissioner Green made the motion, Walker seconded. All was in favor, motion passed.

The written test began shortly after 5:30 p.m. on 10/19/15 in the County Gathertorium Room and concluded around 7:30 p.m.

The computer tests were on 10/29/15 at the DeKalb Police Department's computer training facility. The computer testing process began testing candidates at 5:30 and concluded around 9:30 p.m.

The oral interviews were on 11/9/15 beginning at 5:30 p.m. and concluded around 8:30 p.m.

Commissioner Walker called for a motion to adjourn at 8:37. Kim Green made the motion which was seconded by Todd Walker. On a unanimous voice vote the meeting was adjourned.
