STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLANNING COMMITTEE MINUTES
(May 4, 2017)

The DeKalb County Stormwater Management Planning Committee (SMPC) met of April 20, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. in the DeKalb County Administrative Building, Conference Room – East, in Sycamore, Illinois. However, a quorum was not achieved at that time, thus the meeting was cancelled and rescheduled to May 4, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. in the DeKalb County Administrative Building, Conference Room – East, in Sycamore, Illinois. In attendance were Committee Members: Kevin Bunge, Mark Bushnell, Derek Hiland, Joe Misurelli, Donna Prain, Nathan Schwartz, and Pat Vary. Also in attendance were Dean Johnson and Committee Staff: Marcellus Anderson.

- 1. Roll Call** – Mr. Hiland noted that Committee members Les Bellah, Mr. Holdeman, Mr. Laskowski, Mr. Steimel, Mr. Stoddard, and Mr. Thomas were absent.
- 2. Approval of Agenda** – Mr. Schwartz moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Ms. Prain, and the motion carried unanimously.
- 3. Approval of Minutes** – Mr. Misurelli moved to approve the minutes of the January 19, 2017 meeting, seconded by Ms. Vary, and the motion carried unanimously.
- 4. Update on IEPA 319 Grant Applications**

At the January 19, 2017 meeting of the SMPC, the Committee discussed the request for qualifications received for the Lower South/Upper South Branch of the Kishwaukee River Section 319(h) Watershed Improvement Plan for DeKalb County, Illinois. The Committee recommended using Applied Ecological Services (AES) as the consulting firm to prepare and submit the 319 grant application and as part of the application Dean Johnson, from the DeKalb County Soil and Water Conservation District, discussed the need for a new Steering Committee.

Mr. Johnson presented the Committee members with a handout containing a list of potential candidates for the Steering Committee (included). The Committee discussed the suggested candidates.

Ms. Vary moved to accept the recommendation to appoint the named individuals for membership on the next Watershed Steering Committee, seconded by Mr. Bunge, and the motion carried unanimously.

5. Committee Membership Terms

Mr. Hiland informed the Committee that the terms of service for six (6) Committee members would expire at the end of June. Mr. Hiland informed the Committee that letters were being sent out to chief executive elected official for each of the municipalities requesting their vote for the appointment or reappointment of the three (3) municipal representatives and that the County Administrative Office had been informed of the need to reappoint the three (3) county representatives. He noted that action was expected by the County Board Chair at the June 21, 2017 meeting of the DeKalb County Board.

The Committee discussed the process for nominating potential members and who might be willing and available to serve on the Committee. Mr. Bunge, Mr. Bushnell, and Ms. Vary all indicated their willingness to continue serving on the Committee if they received reappointment. Mr. Hiland indicated that he would follow up with the other people suggested during the discussion.

6. Next Meeting – The Committee will next meet at 2:30 p.m. on August 3, 2017 in the Conference Room East, DeKalb County Administration Building.

7. Adjournment – Mr. Schwartz motioned to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Bushnell, and the motion carried unanimously.

SUBJECT: Member reappointments

The Stormwater Management Planning Committee consists of 12 members, six representing municipalities and six representing the County. For the purpose of establishing the Committee, the County was divided into six areas of more or less equal population. Each area therefore has one Municipal and one County representative. Members of the Committee serve a two-year term, with half of the terms staggered by one year. Members are appointed by the DeKalb County Board Chair. City representatives are voted on first by the mayors/ presidents of all municipalities that are within a given area.

This year, the two-year term expires on June 30, 2019 for the following six members:

Mike Bauling, municipal representative for Area 1;
Mark Bushnell, municipal representative for Area 3; and
Tom Horak, municipal representative for Area 6.

Paul Stoddard, County representative for Area 3;
Pat Vary, County representative for Area 4; and
Kevin Bunge, County representative for Area 6.

Letters are being sent to the chief executive elected official for each of the municipalities requesting their vote for the appointment or re-appointment of the three municipal representatives. The County Administrative Office has been notified of the need to reappoint the three County representatives. Action by the County Board Chair is expected at the June 19, 2019 meeting of the DeKalb County Board.
