WHEREAS, together, we can inspire pride in our county and show the world what makes our communities so great; and

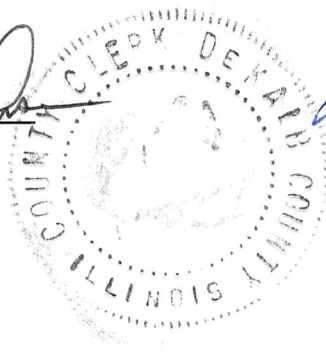
WHEREAS, our community should encourage citizens, organizations, businesses, congregations, and cultural and educational institutions to support this special event; and
