


**EXTENDING A PROCLAMATION OF A DISASTER  
IN DEKALB COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, Mark Pietrowski, Jr., County Board Chairman of DeKalb County Illinois, proclaimed that a disaster exists within DeKalb County, Illinois effective March 18, 2020 for a period not to exceed sixty days, unless extended by the County Board of DeKalb County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) is still prevalent in our community and extraordinary measures are needed for a continued response.


**NOW THEREFORE** I, Mark Pietrowski, Jr. by virtue of the authority vested in me as County Board Chairman of DeKalb County Illinois, pursuant to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305/11, proclaim that the COVID-19 disaster still exists within DeKalb County, Illinois and that the original Proclamation is extended starting May 20, 2020 and shall continue for a period not to exceed thirty days, unless extended by the County Board of DeKalb County.
