Ordinance O2020-13: PDF An Ordinance Amending a Special Use Permit Granted by Ordinances 2005-07, 2009-03 and 2015-03 for a Gun Club and Recreational Camp (Aurora Sportsmen Club) Located Southwest of the Village of Waterman, in Clinton Township. The DeKalb County Board hereby approves this Amendment to be granted with conditions as set forth in the Analysis and Recommendations (Exhibit "B") as outlined in the attached Ordinance. The DeKalb County Board hereby approves this Amendment to be granted for the establishment and operation of a solar garden, referred to IL Kirkland Project 1, on property legally described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto with conditions as set forth in the Analysis and Recommendations (Exhibit "B") as outlined in the attached Ordinance.
