

DeKalb County Sheriff's Merit Commission
Meeting Minutes
Saturday, December 18, 2021

The Merit Commission met in the Sheriff's Situation Room at the DeKalb County Sheriff's Office.

I. Call to Order

Chairman Todd Walker called the meeting to order at 7:52 AM on Dec. 18, 2021.
