

**RESOLUTION
R2022-13**

**A RESOLUTION ABATING THE ENTIRE PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR THE
2021 TAX YEAR FOR RECAPTURE REVENUES**

WHEREAS, DeKalb County Government has an option under 35ILCS 200/18-233 to collect certain property tax dollars related to prior year adjustments for certificates in error, Property Tax Appeal Board final administrative decision and qualified court orders; and

WHEREAS, these funds are automatically recognized and reflected on each taxing district's Levy Confirmation; and

WHEREAS, the DeKalb County Board took action to levy property taxes in a manner that would capture revenue from new construction and TIF increment while aiming to keep taxes paid by existing tax payers roughly the same on average; and

WHEREAS, the DeKalb County Board may abate these "Recapture Revenues" to maintain the intent of the approved levy; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee of the County Board recommends that these "Recapture Revenues" be abated in its entirety; and


WHEREAS, the County Board does desire to abate the property tax levy for the 2021 Tax Year (payable in 2022) for "Recapture Revenues" under 35ILCS 200/18-233;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the DeKalb County Board that the \$99,179 property tax levy for the 2021 Tax Year (payable in 2022), which was levied under 35ILCS 200/18-233 for "Recapture Revenues", is hereby abated in its entirety in the amount of \$99,179, and that a certified copy of this Resolution should be filed with the DeKalb County Clerk within fifteen days.
