The Housing Authority of DeKalb County is seeking candidates for two open seats on their Board of Commissioners.

The Housing Authority of the County of DeKalb (HACD) is governed by a 5-member Board of Commissioners. The Board is responsible for overseeing policies, operations, and expenditures. Commissioners chart the direction of the HACD by assessing community needs and setting organizational goals.

Commissioners are appointed by the DeKalb County Board. The board is made up of members of the DeKalb County Area, all dedicated to HACD mission.

- **1 Position – A five-year term beginning November 1, 2022 and expiring October 31, 2027. This position is a Resident Commissioner. An applicant will need to be assisted by the Housing Authority.**
