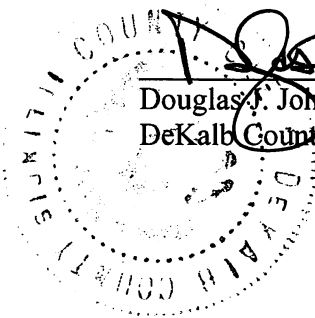

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE CITY OF DeKalb, IL AND COUNTY OF DeKalb, IL

JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM AWARD

This Agreement is made and entered into this 11th day of October, 2022, by and between the DeKalb County Sheriff's Department and the DeKalb Police Department

WHEREAS, each governing body, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder, shall make that performance or those payments from current revenues legally available to that party: and

WHEREAS, each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services or functions under this agreement: and

WHEREAS, the CITY'S share of the grant funds is \$9916 from the JAG award for the DeKalb Police Department and the DeKalb County Sheriff's Department: and

WHEREAS, the CITY believes it to be in its best interest to allow the COUNTY to retain the CITY'S share of the grant funds, upon which the COUNTY will reallocate all of the JAG funds for the DeKalb Police Department and DeKalb County Sheriff's Department. A total of \$19,832.

NOW THEREFORE, the COUNTY and CITY agree as follows:

Section 1

CITY agrees to allow COUNTY to retain the CITY'S share of JAG funds, a total of \$9916, for the purpose of allowing the COUNTY to use the sum total of the JAG funds to acquire Mobile Communications Terminals, (MCT'S) for the DeKalb County Sheriff's Department.

Section 2

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against COUNTY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the Illinois Governmental Tort Liability Act.

Section 3

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against CITY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the Illinois Governmental Tort Liability Act.

Section 4

Each party to this agreement will be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other party.

Section 5

The parties to this Agreement do not intend for any third party to obtain a right by virtue of this Agreement.

Section 6

By entering into this Agreement, the parties do not intend to create any obligations express or implied other than those set out herein; further, this Agreement shall not create any rights in any party not a signatory hereto.
