



Effective the date of this Order, pursuant to 20 ILCS 301/5-23 Drug Overdose Prevention Program and 820 ILCS 315/1 (from Ch. 48, par. 281) Line of Duty Compensation Act, probation officers of the Twenty-Third Judicial Circuit are authorized to carry and administer Naloxone to persons experiencing or suspected of experiencing opioid-related overdoses. There is no legal obligation to administer Naloxone.

The Director of Probation in each of the counties of the Twenty-Third Judicial Circuit (DeKalb and Kendall) may establish policies and procedures for their respective departments in compliance with the Supreme Court of Illinois Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts Anti-Opioid Program and Administration Standards dated October 2022.
