A Resolution Entering into an Agreement with the State of Illinois to Designate Class II Truck Routes.

Be it resolved by the DeKalb County Board of the County of DeKalb, Illinois as follows:

WHEREAS, it is required to necessitate an agreement with the State of Illinois for certain improvements to County Highway 24, Chicago Road from Lee County Line to Shabbona Road and County Highway 6, Rollo Road from Chicago Road to W Suydam Road and County Highway 6, W Suydam Road from Rollo Road to LaSalle County Line; and

WHEREAS, 625 ILCS 5/1-126.1 provides that local authorities may designate Class II Truck Route highways within their jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, when said certain improvements designated as Section Number 20-00274-00-RS are completed and the roads have appropriate signage, DeKalb County desires to designate these roads as Class II Truck Routes.

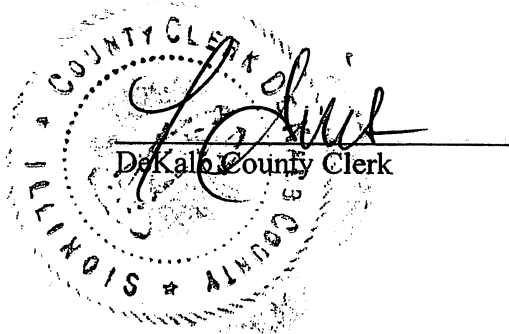
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the DeKalb County Board that it does authorize its Chair to execute the appropriate Local Agency Agreement to designate County Highway 24, Chicago Road from Lee County Line to Shabbona Road and County Highway 6, Rollo Road from Chicago Road to W Suydam Road and County Highway 6, W Suydam Road from Rollo Road to LaSalle County Line as Class II Truck Route highways under the Truck Access Route Program (TARP) funded with the State of Illinois.

WHEREAS, 625 ILCS 5/1-126.1 provides that local authorities may designate Class II or Prohibited Truck Route highways within their jurisdiction, and its accordance with 625 ILCS 5/15-111(f), weight limitations shall be designated by appropriate signs placed on such highways; and

WHEREAS, County of DeKalb County is desirous of designating truck routes under their jurisdiction as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the portion of roadways as listed below will be designated as shown.

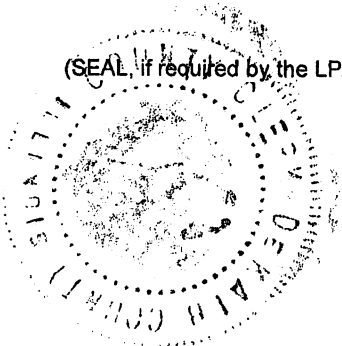
